Genesis 1-7 – CHAOS/ORDER/CHAOS:


Begins and ends with chaos initially subdued and brought to order through God's Spirit/wind/breath. Due to sin, God removes his Spirit, releases the chaotic and destructive forces in a flood, as judgment.

Genesis 6:5-8







Genesis 12-50

God initiates and begins to work out a new plan through Abraham (a promise and plan of deliverance instead of judgment).

Genesis 1:2 and 8:1

Just like God's promise to bless all peoples through the seed of Abraham, God's Spirit/Wind/Breath plays a critical role, at every creative and redemptive act of God to follow in God's story.

Jesus, the Messiah/Son of God

16 As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw *the Spirit of God descending like a dove* and alighting on him. 17 And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased." (Mt. 3:16-17)

Pentecost - Jews

2 Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. 3 They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. 4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. (Acts 2:2-4, NIV)

Cornelius – Gentiles

44 While Peter was still speaking these words, the *Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message*. 45 The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that *the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on Gentiles*. 46 For they heard them speaking in tongues and praising God.

Then Peter said, 47 "Surely no one can stand in the way of their being baptized with water. They have *received the Holy Spirit just as we have.*" 48 So he ordered that they be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. (Acts 2:44-48, NIV)

Nicodemus

3 Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again."

4 "How can someone be born when they are old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely they cannot enter a second time into their mother's womb to be born!"

5 Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the *Spirit*.

Nicodemus

6 Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. 7 You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' 8 The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the *Spirit*." (Jn. 3:3-8)

Spirit Given at Baptism
