It's always a delight to share with our supporters and friends news pertaining to the Lord's work in Haiti. I want to express my gratitude for your fellowship in the gospel. While we are writing this report this country is under a state of siege. Since the first of September, Haiti has experienced extremely difficult conditions due to ongoing political protests, soaring inflation of 20%, and dwindling fuel and food supplies. Protests and roadblocks are rampant across the country, resulting in the following:

Schools are not meeting. Children are not receiving a school lunch like they were.

People are not working. Many individuals cannot get to work, which means they are without regular income to purchase food for their families.

No one can go anywhere. Even for those who are able to work, getting to the store is nearly impossible. However, the church is still meeting, and the gospel is still being spread.

<u>Highlights</u>

We have had 56 baptisms into Christ, and 4 gospel meetings at St Michel, Delmas, Titanyan and Thomazeau. I have attended to 12 weddings and one funeral.
